Race Bulletin No. 2 (Acceptance)

Organisation

The event is being organised by Xscape Race Team on behalf of Snowsport England.

Entry Criteria

The Club National event is open to home nation registered racers in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior and Masters. The Minis race follows the same format, and is open to home nation registered racers born in 1998-2001.

Acceptance

At the acceptance meeting held on Friday 23rd May, the Jury considered the entries from 19 Girls and 17 Boys in the Minis event. In accordance with SSE Race Manual 4.14.2 all valid entries were accepted.

Entries for 63 Females and 102 Males in the Club National event were received and considered by the Jury.

Under BACR 200.3 competitions are open only to properly licensed competitors. Other limitations may be included if specified and published in the programme. SSE Race Manual 4.3.1 stipulates Eligibility and the requirements for registration with a recognised HNGB registration scheme. As proof of current registration could not be established for the following competitors their entries could not be accepted:

The slope advised a maximum of entry of 160 including minis. Preference in Club National events is given to racers with higher (or no) seed points. The Jury considered the proportion of valid entries received from both male and female competitors, the ratio of nationally registered athletes and the ranges of seed points involved. Those entries that have not been accepted will receive a refund of their entry fee - if you paid by cheque, this will be returned to you by post in the next couple of days. Those who entered via the online payment system, will have their monies refunded direct to their banks. Please be aware that this may take a few days to complete.

Late Entries

The race being heavily over-subscribed at the closing date, the jury will not be accepting late entries.

Refunds

Now that the acceptance list has been published, further refunds will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.

Race Format

This race will be run as a two-run race, with a different course for each run. This is different to outdoor Club Nationals which have three runs over the same course. This difference is due to the nature of running on snow, where the snow would simply not stand up to holding three complete runs down the same course.

The results for this race will be determined from the total of the times from the two runs. Thus a competitor must complete both runs to be eligible for an age category or overall prize.

However, in recognition of its position as an 'entry' level race, the British TD Forum have agreed to allow each run will be seeded as a separate race. Thus a racer achieving a finish in only one of the two runs will still gain a result that will count for seeding.

In the Minis race all entries will be drawn for start order. In the Club National race the BARTS Seed list 2008.1 will be used to determine start order. The top 15 females and 15 males will be drawn for start position for the first run, with the remaining seeded racers placed in ascending seed point order.

The first run will be run in ascending bib number order, first the Minis event (Girls then Boys) followed by the Club National event (Females then Males).

For the second run, the start order will simply reverse the order from the first run. The Minis event will again run first (this time Boys then Girls in descending bib number order), then the Club National event, this time Males followed by Females, again in descending bib number order.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times, but the organisers reserve the right to change the times if necessary. Please check the race notice board on arrival and listen out for announcements over the PA system.

Race Rules/Health and Safety

The race will be run under F.I.S. rules as varied by Snowsport GB and Snowsport England and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) and Snowsport England Race Manual. Your attention is drawn to SSE Alpine Racing Bulletins that detail key points of current regulations. All are available for download from <http://www.gbski.com> and/or <http://www.britski.org>.

Competitors are reminded of the regulations governing the limits of ski/binding heights. TDs have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behaviour rule to any racer using bad language. All participants must wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet appropriate for skiing during training and competitions (the European Standard for ski helmets is BS EN 1077:1996 Specification for helmets for alpine skiers).

Course Inspection and Access to Competition Area

Racers inspecting the course must wear skis and wear bibs with their number clearly visible. No one is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Any instructions from the Jury regarding the method of inspection must be followed.

Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers on skis during inspection, provided they are qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race. The coaches accreditation form is available for download from <http://www.britski.org/Coaches.pdf>. Those who are already accredited by the Coaches

forum do not need to request Accreditation again but must wear the Accreditation whilst they are within the competition area.

The limited space available in the Start Area means that coaches or racer 'assistants' will not be allowed in the start area. All those within the competition area are reminded of their obligation to follow any instructions of the Jury.

Photography

Athletes who do not wish to be photographed by the accredited photographer must notify the Race Secretary in writing or email before the event. No other photographers will be permitted on the slope without prior accreditation by the organisers. Those athletes entering online have the option to opt out when registering for the race.

Doping Control

Competitors should note that the Dope Control Unit may arrive unannounced at any event and will have the complete co-operation of the organisers of this race. There have been a number of recent amendments to the Doping Control Regulations; these changes mainly affect two groups of competitors, those who suffer from asthma and taking asthma medication and those using insulin to treat insulin-dependent diabetes. The result of these new regulations is that any competitor using these drugs must obtain certification in writing from the doctor prescribing them or from the team physician. A form on which to obtain the appropriate certification is available from the SSE Head Office. This certificate must be completed in advance of competition and returned to the SSE Medical Advisor with a SAE for Acknowledgement of Notification to be returned to you. All competitors should note that this notification is required annually.

Awards

Awards will be made (based on the results of both runs added together) in the following categories:

For the purposes of Club National races, Seniors and Masters are designated as separate age groups. The winners will be expected to show due courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

Race Office

The race office will be at the Race Secretary's address until the evening of Saturday 31st May, and will be located at SNO!zone Milton Keynes from 07.30 Sunday 1st June.

Ski hire

Please take note that for this event skis will not be available for hire from the Ski Centre.

Use of Non-Race Slope

Free skiing on the non-race slope from 0800 - 0900 is included as part of the entry fee. Thereafter, if racers wish to ski on the non-race slope, they will have to pay at standard rate available to the general public. Any racer who elects to ski on the non-race slope must bear in mind that the slope is open to the general public and extreme care will be needed. Slope staff will remove anyone skiing in an inconsiderate manner and there will be no refund of unused fee.

Skis and Equipment

A designated area will be set aside for competitor's skis, but due to the limited space available we would ask that you show common sense in the use of this area and try to keep it as tidy as possible. As there is also limited space inside the 'fridge', competitors skis cannot be left at the bottom of the slope for health and safety reasons. Ski boots may only be worn in the changing/locker area and within the arena itself.

Please note also that the venue will be open to the public, so you should show due consideration to other slope users and visitors, and remember that your kit is your responsibility and should not be left unsupervised. SNO!zone and the organisers cannot take responsibility for any equipment that is lost or stolen.

Commentator sheets & Race Bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall no later than the completion of the final run. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £25.00 for each missing bib.

Refreshments / Catering

A range of refreshments and food will be available from the Ski Centre during the race.

Directions

Postcode for Sat Nav : MK9 3XS

From the M1 : Leave M1 at Junction 14 and take the A509 towards Central Milton Keynes. At the first roundabout take the second exit H6 Childs Way. Stay on this road over the next 5 roundabouts (the Xscape building is now on your right), at the 6th roundabout (South Secklow roundabout) turn right. At the first set of traffic lights turn right onto Avebury Boulevard, Xscape is now on your right with pay & display parking for over 1000 cars.

From the A5 : Leave the A5 at the exit towards Milton Keynes Central (A509) and take the third exit on the roundabout, signposted A509. Cross 3 roundabouts, and at the fourth, take the third exit onto Secklow Gate. Take the next left at Silbury Boulevard. Take the next left at North 13th Street. Turn right onto Marlborough Gate. Xscape is now on your left.

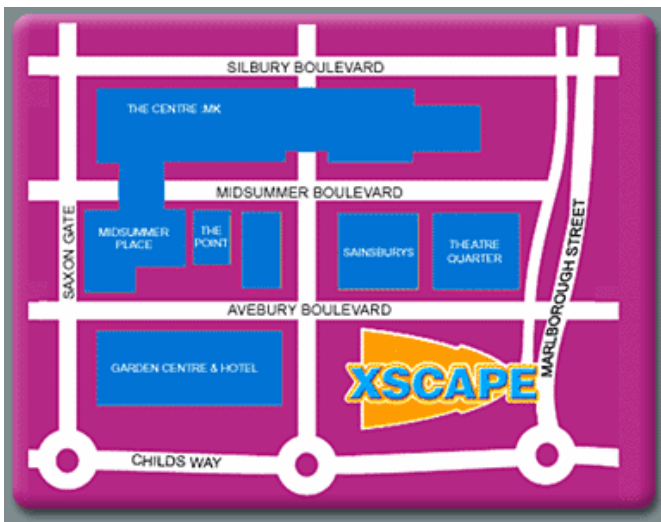
