Race Bulletin: Acceptance

Organisation



The race is being organised by Eastern Region Ski Association (ERSA). ERSA is pleased to acknowledge the support of The Snow Centre (Hemel) and clubs within the region. We would like to thank the management and staff of The Snow Centre, Hemel Hempstead, and all volunteers for their assistance, without which there would be not be a race.

Entry Criteria

The ERSA Champs is a special slalom of 2 runs down 2 different courses and is open to ERSA registered clubs with competitors in the following categories: Minis, Children 1, Children 2, Junior 1, Junior 2, Seniors and Masters. All racers must have ERSA Seed Points.

The Minis Race (Boys and Girls Race) will consist of the following ERSA categories, Minis, BG1 and BG2.

Run 1, the top 15 female and male athletes will be drawn at random and the remainder drawn according to ERSA points, the lowest pointed drawn racers allocated the lower bib numbers and compete first. Minis will be drawn at random and will race on the female course. Girls compete separately from the Boys. Girls race first followed by the boys.

Run 2, the start order for the second run is determined by the result list of the first run except for the first 30 places. For those first 30 places the starting order is as follows:- the 30th in the result list starts 1st - the 29th in the result list starts 2nd - etc. That is, the top 30 are reversed.

Mini's 2nd run will be reversed from the start order of Run 1, run on the female course. Boys will race first followed by the Girls.

Competitors who do not finish or are disqualified in the 1st run will not be allowed to compete in the 2nd run. This may be varied at the discretion of the Jury. Please listen to commentary.

Programme

The times given below are provisional and may alter on the day, but in order to meet the tight timescales please ensure you are ready to start on time and listen carefully for announcements.

Provisional timetable:

07.00	Course Setting, both Male and Female courses set at same time.
07.30	Open Practice on main fenced off area or side slope only, Bibs MUST be worn.

07.45	Course inspection for all categories, open practice continues.
08.15	Open Practice ends. Course Inspection ends.
08.30	Start of Run 1 . (Course setting for Run 2 takes place during Run 1 on other half of slope)
10.00	Inspection 2 nd run
10.30	Start of Run 2
12.00	End of individual runs
12.30	Team events if time and conditions permit
14.00	Prize giving in The Edge Café Bar

At present it is planned to hold the "Team Events" but this may need to be adapted depending to circumstances. Every attempt will be made to keep to the above schedule. The organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule as appropriate. Racers will have access to the Changing Rooms and lockers for valuables will be available (£1.00 coin needed - returned). The Snow Centre and ERSA will accept no responsibility for equipment or valuables left unattended.

Open Practice is the designated area on the main slope is included in the race entry fee. Thereafter, if racers wish to ski on the non-race slope, they will have to pay at the standard rate available to the general public.

Acceptance

At the Jury meeting held on Sunday 27th September the following entries were considered. Entries from 146 competitors were received and considered for entry, (13 Girls, 13 Boys 42 Females and 78 Males). All racers are required to have ERSA points. Entries from 12 Girls, 12 Boys 42 Females and 77 Males were accepted. The following racers were not accepted as they did not meet the entry criteria: **Megan Davies, Morgan Davies and Jordan Lowe.**

The race is now closed; no late entries will be accepted.

The start order for the 1st run will be drawn on Wednesday 30th September using ERSA seed list version 906. This seed list may be found on

Open Practice

BIBS MUST BE WORN, Athletes without bibs will not be permitted onto the uplift. Open Practice will take place on the side slope or fenced off main slope from 07.30h - 08.15h and is part of the entry fee. Any racer found skiing on the side slope after this time will be immediately disqualified. Thereafter the public will be admitted to the centre for lessons on the side slope. Please remember this period is for open practice only and not to enable racers to ski on "snow". Anyone found abusing this right will be asked to leave the slope. Please be considerate with the number of open practice runs as there are lots of athletes to accommodate in the short period available.

Any racer found skiing in an inconsiderate or dangerous manner during open practice will be asked to leave the slope. Hemel Snow Centre staff and race organisers will monitor this. During the open practice period course inspection will take place.

Race Rules/Health and Safety

The race will be run under SSE. rules as varied by ERSA and published on the ERSA website at http://www.ersa.co.uk/Rules/SL_Rules_2009.pdf Additional rule specific to this indoor snow races are as follows.

- The courses will be set using single flex slalom poles as agreed in the FIS precisions 2009.
- Once at the top of the slope no one will be allowed down to the bottom until the end of that run. (Does not apply to authorised officials)
- Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection. Inspection on foot by either racers or coaches is NOT permissible. Skis or correctly fitted snow blades must be worn. Likewise no person is allowed in the Snow arena without skis or boots. This will be varied for various official duties. Bibs or accredited passes must be worn.
- CATSUIITS are NOT recommended. NO CATSUIITS to be worn by the Mini category. (Born 1999 and after).

First Aid

First aid cover will be provided by the Snow Centre and ERSA.

Ski Preparation

The Snow Centre will set up a Gazebo in the car park with tarpaulin on the floor for anyone needing to prep skis.

No ski prep is to take place in the building, including the boot room or in the car park except in the designated area.

Ski Storage

There are ski racks behind the netting but once these are full skiers will have to store their skis in the changing room or back in their cars, the Snow Centre cannot have skis in front of the fire exit on the slope. Lockers are provided in the changing area (refundable £1 deposit). Hemel Snow Centre accepts no responsibility for valuables or equipment left unattended. Ski boots may be worn anywhere within the centre but no skis are to be taken to the "Edge" café/bar area.

Race Officials

Officials will also be required to wear a hi-viz jacket showing that you are an official; otherwise you will not be allowed to enter the slope. Officials should either be on skis or if you are located towards the bottom of the slope you may borrow some snowboard boots to wear. **No outdoor shoes are permitted on the slope.**

Notes

Racer assistants (e.g. coach or parent) will not be allowed in the Start Area because of the restricted size of the start area and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of arena.

- Inspection on foot either by racers or coaches is not permissible
- In order to preserve the racing surface, racers may not pass through gates during the inspection unless notified by the race jury.. **The inspection must be carried from the side of the course.**
- **NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED WITHIN THE SNOW ARENA UNLESS PRE ARRANGED WITH THE ORGANISERS.**

Please comply with all instructions from the "Slope Patrol" or authorised persons.

Refreshments

The EDGE Café Bar is located on the top floor of the Snow Centre. For this race The Edge are laying on the following race menu. *All food must be purchased from The Snow Centre, no food or beverages may be bought into The Snow Centre. No BBQ's to be used in the car park.*

Commentator Sheets and Race Bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib from your race manager. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the second run, failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib. The Finish Marshall will be located in the changing room by the exit from the snow. Competitors who do not qualify for the 2nd run should return their bib to the Race Office at the top of the stairs on the top floor of the Snow Centre unless advised otherwise.

Protocol /Referee's Report

Protests against the Referee's Report must be made on official forms, which will be available from the race Office. The form must be completed and returned to the Race Secretary within the published time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.

Practice Session

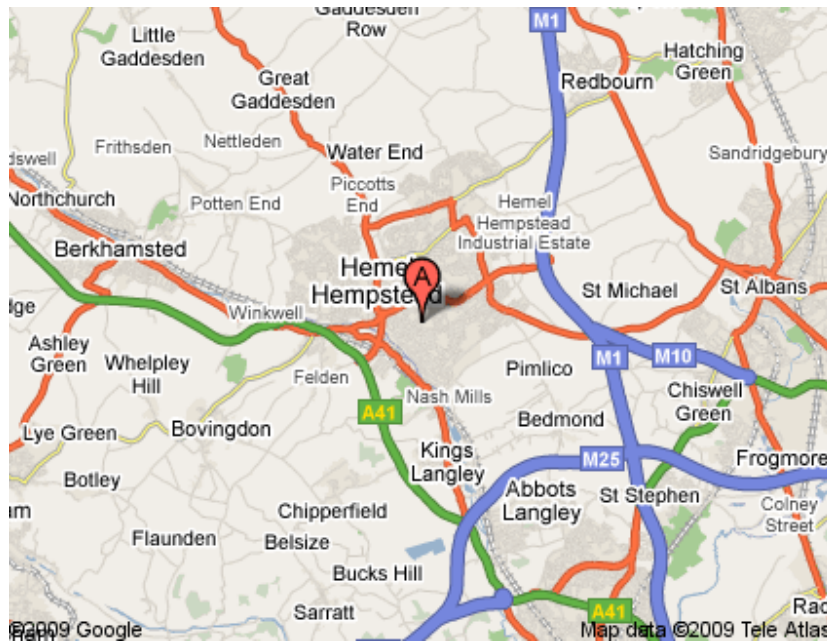
No specific time or area has been provided by Hemel Snow Centre for practise on the Saturday prior to the event.

The Snow Centre have kindly agreed that racers who are competing in the Sunday ERSA Champs event may practice at the Snow Centre on Saturday 3rd October 2009 at a discounted rate of £15 for 1 hour or £25 for 2 hours; subject to availability. This offer is strictly limited to the ERSA Champs competitors. A start list will be provided to the centre and only those on the list will be able to obtain the discounted rate. The Snow Centre will be open to the public at this time so **no high speed skiing** will be tolerated. Respect must be given to all other slope users and any instructions given by Snow Centre staff must be obeyed.
